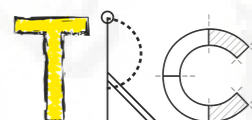

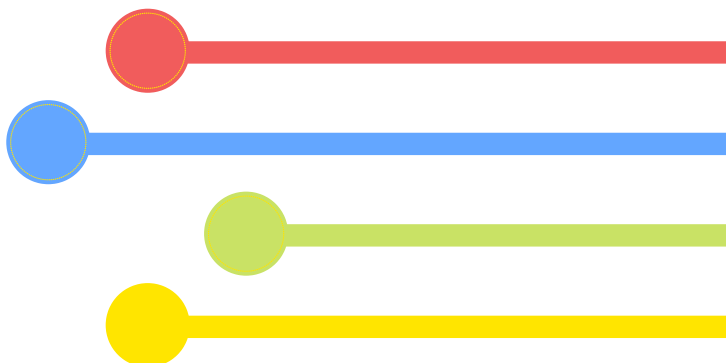

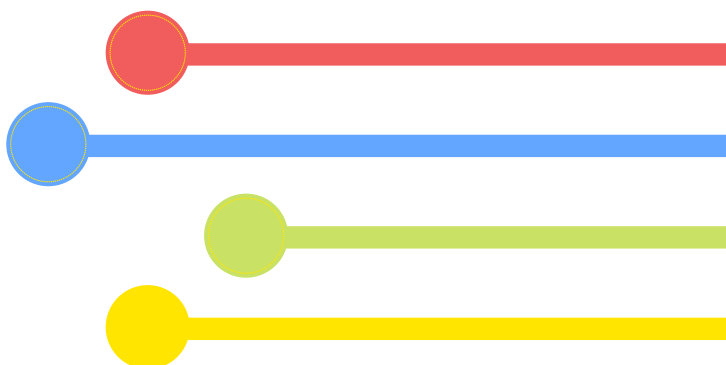
This 6-month Diploma Course in ECE is based on 7 Modules:

- OBSERVING & ASSESSING LEARNING

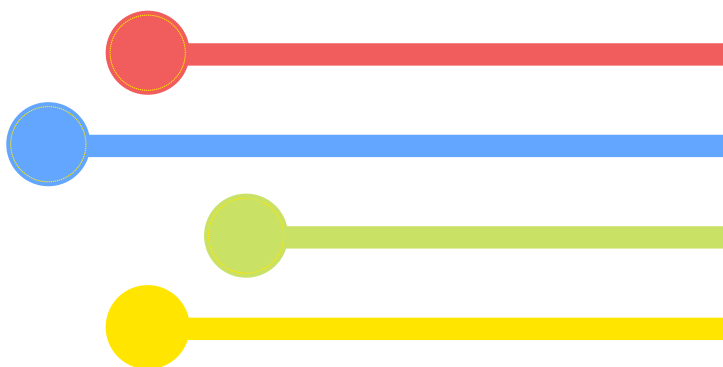

It has been running a one-year diploma in ECE for the last 14 years, which has been accredited by CACHE UK for the last 3 years.

In response to numerous requests for a short course in ECE, TRC is now happy to announce a 6-month Diploma course in Early Childhood Education that is based on building strong foundations in the Early Years.



The course modules will be taught by a set of highly experienced and committed faculty, supported by latest research and developments in the field. The 7 modules have been designed to explore the concept and image of childhood and to examine the varied influences that have made ECE what it is today. The course endeavours to equip educators with the necessary knowledge and skills to plan and implement child-centred active learning/play experiences for children aged 3 to 8 years. The content of this course will walk you through the developmentally appropriate practices with an emphasis on Key Learning Areas and Competencies from the National Curriculum for ECE.



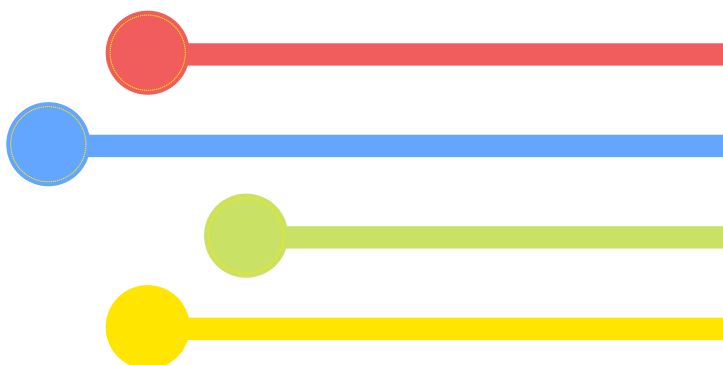
